Sunrise Ridge Park, located on Faria Parkway, is in the final phases of construction, and we anticipate the park being opened to the public with a ribbon-cutting ceremony and festivities in May. Please check the City website at [www.sanramon.ca.gov](http://www.sanramon.ca.gov) for details on the grand opening in the coming weeks. If you observe anyone using the park for sporting and other recreational activities prior to the grand opening, please call the non-emergency police number (925) 973-2779.

On Monday, March 11, 2024, the sports field lights in Sunrise Ridge Park will be turned on as a test from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. to assess their impact on the surrounding neighborhood. Sports field lights throughout the city are turned on between dusk and 10 p.m. when fields are reserved and in use by local sports leagues. The Parks Commission will be discussing the Sunrise Ridge sports field lighting at their Wednesday, March 13, 2024, meeting at 7 p.m. at San Ramon City Hall, 7000 Bollinger Canyon Road.
