RESOLUTION NO. 2022-098

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN RAMON ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTARY CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURE LIMITATION FOR THE 2022 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, inherent in the high cost of election campaigns is the possibility and the appearance of improper influence real or potential, exercised by campaign contributors over elective officials; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, through the voluntary actions of City Council candidates, seeks to preserve and foster an orderly political forum in which persons may express themselves effectively, to decrease the cost of campaigns, and to prevent the appearance of improper influence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds \$69,402 which approximates the sum of \$1.40 per registered voter, is a reasonable limit for funds to be spent by individual candidates for Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds \$31,427, which approximates the sum of \$2.35 per registered voter, is a reasonable limit for funds to be spent by individual candidates for Councilmember District 2; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds \$25,848, which approximates the sum of \$2.35 per registered voter, is a reasonable limit for funds to be spent by individual candidates for Councilmember District 4; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures counting towards the limits will commence at the formation of the committee and will conclude on December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, under authority of Government Code Section 85400 (Political Reform Act of 1996) of Section A 3-13 of the San Ramon Municipal Code, that the sum of \$69,402 for Mayor, \$31,427 for Councilmember District 2, and \$25,848 for Councilmember District 4 is established as the campaign expenditure limits for the 2022 Municipal Election.

I agree to abide by the Voluntary Campaign Expenditure Limit for the 2022 Mubicipal Election

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California Secretary of State CODE OF FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES (Elections Code § 20440)

There are basic principles of decency, honesty, and fair play which every candidate for public office in the State of California has a moral obligation to observe and uphold in order that, after vigorously contested but fairly conducted campaigns, our citizens may exercise their constitutional right to a free and untrammeled choice and the will of the people may be fully and clearly expressed on the issues.

THEREFORE:

- (1) I SHALL CONDUCT my campaign openly and publicly, discussing the issues as I see them, presenting my record and policies with sincerity and frankness, and criticizing without fear or favor the record and policies of my opponents or political parties that merit this criticism.
- (2) I SHALL NOT USE OR PERMIT the use of character defamation, whispering campaigns, libel, slander, or scurrilous attacks on any candidate or his or her personal or family life.
- (3) I SHALL NOT USE OR PERMIT any appeal to negative prejudice based on a candidate's actual or perceived race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, marital status, age, sexual orientation, sex, including gender identity, or any other characteristic set forth in Section 12940 of the Government Code, or association with another person who has any of the actual or perceived characteristics set forth in Section 12940 of the Government Code.
- (4) I SHALL NOT USE OR PERMIT any dishonest or unethical practice that tends to corrupt or undermine our American system of free elections, or that hampers or prevents the full and free expression of the will of the voters including acts intended to hinder or prevent any eligible person from registering to vote, enrolling to vote, or voting.
- (5) I SHALL NOT coerce election help or campaign contributions for myself or for any other candidate from my employees.
- (6) I SHALL IMMEDIATELY AND PUBLICLY REPUDIATE support deriving from any individual or group that resorts, on behalf of my candidacy or in opposition to that of my opponent, to the methods and tactics that I condemn. I shall accept responsibility to take firm action against any subordinate who violates any provision of this code or the laws governing elections.
- (7) I SHALL DEFEND AND UPHOLD the right of every qualified American voter to full and equal participation in the electoral process.

I, the undersigned, candidate for election to public office in the State of California or treasurer or chairperson of a committee making any independent expenditures, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct my campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.

- 1. I shall conduct my campaign for City Council openly and fairly.
- 2. I shall discuss the issues and participate in fair debate with respect to my views and qualifications.
- 3. I shall not engage in, or permit to the extent possible, defamatory attacks on the character of my opponents; nor shall I engage in unwarranted invasions of personal privacy unrelated to campaign issues.
- 4. I shall not at any time use or permit the use of any campaign material or advertisement which misrepresents, distorts, or otherwise falsifies the facts regarding any candidate or the candidate's position on issues.
- 5. I shall clearly identify myself, or my campaign committee(s), as the sender of all of my campaign mailings.
- 6. I shall personally approve in writing all of my campaign material, advertisements, or mailings, prior to their use.
- 7. I shall publicly repudiate support derived from any individual or group whose activities would violate this Fair Campaign pledge.
- 8. I shall file all campaign statements as required by the California Political Reform Act and the City of San Ramon Campaign Ordinance, on time and with full disclosure of campaign contributions and expenditures.
- 9. I shall not duplicate or use any lists of contributors filed by any other candidates for the purpose of compiling my own mailing lists without the permission of the other candidate.
- 10. I shall attempt to limit all expenditures on behalf of my campaign to a sum not to exceed the campaign limit expenditure amount set for the current election by Resolution of the City Council, a copy of which is included in the packet distributed with the nomination papers.
- 11. I shall, insofar as is practical, participate in joint mailing activities with other City Council candidates.
- 12. I shall not post nor permit to be posted on my behalf any signs, posters or other displays on any public or utility owned property or public rights of way.
- 13. I shall remove all signs, posters or other displays within seven days after the municipal election in which I was the candidate.
- 14. I, the undersigned candidate for election to the San Ramon City Council, hereby voluntarily endorse, subscribe to, and solemnly pledge myself to conduct my campaign in accordance with the above principles and practices.
