Make Your Own Festival-Inspired Waffle Pops



These are candy coated waffle pops and they're a huge hit at festivals. What is great about these pops is that they're relatively easy to make and completely photo worthy! Here's a quick guide on making your own festival-inspired treats, specifically these waffle pops.

What You'll Need:

- Waffle iron
- Your favorite waffle batter mix (Bisquick, etc)
- Popsicle sticks
- Non-stick cooking spray
- Your favorite sweet toppings

Depending on what type of waffle pop you want to make, you'll want different sweet toppings, but we recommend:

- chocolate melt
- candy sprinkles
- warm, somewhat melted peanut butter
- cocoa powders
- diced fruit
- · confectioners sugar

How to Make Them:

- Once you've got your waffle mix ready to go and the iron is hot, pour the mix in the iron.
- IMMEDIATELY lay your popsicle stick on the batter with about 1/3 of the stick hanging off the edge of the iron. You'll want enough room to hold the waffle pop.
- Pour a little more batter over the popsicle stick
- Then, close the iron and cook the waffles as you would normally

Once they're done, carefully remove the waffles with a fork and allow them to cool. Once they're cooled to room temp, you can cut them in serving portions and then the fun begins. The type of waffle you make is really up to you, but we encourage you to be creative and try things that you normally wouldn't.
