

Faria Preserve Development Existing EBMUD Reservoir on Deerwood Road (February 2018)

In conjunction with The Preserve development, EBMUD has been conducting rehabilitation work on their existing San Ramon Reservoir off of Deerwood Road. This Reservoir is a critical facility for EBMUD that serves San Ramon, Danville and the surrounding area. Work began last November when EBMUD removed the reservoir from service to conduct renovations and repair. EBMUD chose the winter months to do this renovation and repair work since water demand is lower during the winter months. EBMUD anticipated the work to be completed by late February; however, due to some unforeseen conditions inside the reservoir and delays in receiving new pumping plant power and new water piping from future Faria Parkway, EBMUD now anticipates the work to be completed by late April. In order to reduce any further impacts to the schedule, and restore water service as soon as possible, work hours specific to work on this existing reservoir are 7:30 am – 5:30 pm on weekdays and 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturdays. The City may extend weekday hours to 6:00 pm as daylight hours increase and may occasionally allow Sunday work from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm.
