



## **PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT 2023 PROJECT, AND CITYWIDE NETWORK IMPROVEMENTS & ENHANCEMENTS - UPDATE**

### **PLANNED DATES for SLURRY SEAL: Spring 2024**

The contractor, DRYCO Construction, Inc., for the Pavement Management 2023 Project, and Citywide Network Improvements & Enhancements requested a temporary suspension of slurry seal pavement treatment work due to weather conditions. Typically, weather in the winter months is not conducive to slurry seal pavement treatment. Therefore, the City is allowing for a temporary suspension of slurry seal pavement treatment, while the weather is such that it will have a negative effect on the quality of the slurry seal. The contractor plans to continue slurry seal work in Spring of 2024.

Streets which have received slurry seal and cape seal treatments will be completed with striping, markings, and markers.

Residents will be notified 2 weeks prior to the Contractor continuing with slurry seal pavement treatments.
